This fab Corktown unit proves not all condos are created equal. Here, soaring ceilings, loft-like details and low maintenance finishes make this space a must-see.

The layout is really efficient - no wasted space here. You'll be pleasantly surprised by the roominess of the bedroom and the large closet. The kitchen has good storage and new lighting, which makes the space as fashionable as it is functional.

Here, in the kitchen/living area, you get the full effect of the high ceilings, exposed ductwork and smooth,

Corktown District II has a variety of amenities including a media/party room, meeting room, rec room, gym and security. There is a concierge, visitor parking and, perhaps most importantly, an enviable rooftop patio that looks out over the east end and lake.

This neighbourhood is transforming fast — back in the day, the east side used to be a bit down and out, but today it's booming. A lucky few will get to be a part of this incredible growth. The rest will have to bike over to wait in line for brunch on weekends.

You don't have to go far to see what's happening: The Canary district to the south, Regent Park revitalization to the north, and over the bridge to the east easy-to-manage concrete floors.
